PHOTO IDENTIFICATION WILL BE REQUIRED

Each elector will be required to have picture identification with his signature upon it when presenting himself or herself to vote in their precinct.

Any combination of the following that shows picture and signature are acceptable:

- Florida driver's license
- Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
- United States passport
- Debit or credit card
- Military identification
- Student identification
- Retirement center identification
- Neighborhood association identification
- Public assistance identification
- Veteran health identification card issued by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
- License to carry a concealed weapon or firearm issued pursuant to s. 790.06
- Employee identification card issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the Federal Government, the state, a county, or a municipality.

If electors don't have either of the above identification, they must vote a provisional ballot.
