CHANGES TO VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT REQUESTS

- You can only request a vote-by-mail ballot for all elections through the end of the calendar year of the next regularly scheduled general election. Any requests that are already on file will be valid for the 2022 election cycle, then you will need to request them again.
- To request a vote-by-mail ballot in-person, in writing or by phone, the voter must provide their Florida driver license number, Florida ID card number or the last four digits of their social security number.
- Written requests must include the voter's signature.

The Elections Office will notify voters who have requests on file when their requests are expiring.

CHANGES TO VOTE BY MAIL RETURNS

- Drop boxes will only be available during Early Voting hours. (They will no longer be available 24 hours a day)
- You can only drop off 2 vote-by-mail ballots plus your ballot and the ballots of your immediate family members.

CHANGES TO VOTER REGISTRATION

- You will need your Florida driver license number, Florida ID card number or the last four digits of your social security number to update the address on your voter registration record.
- Name and party changes must be submitted on a Florida Voter Registration Application and must include your Florida driver license number, Florida ID card number or the last four digits of your social security number.
